There's no shortage of rainfall in this part of the world, but you'd never know it by the condition of the golf course. The greens were true and the fairways well-maintained. (I was playing links golf at some considerably pricier courses on the East Lothian coast a couple of weeks previously and St David's City GC stands up well in comparison).

The setting ensures wonderful views from every part of the golf course, but the 4th/13th deserves special mention, running close and parallel to Whitesands Beach with the spectacular coastline dropping off to your right.

I had a couple of brief conversations with local members (who were very friendly and welcoming) and Phil the greenkeeper came over for a chat and to offer advice on the course layout. (It's made up of 9 greens and 18 tees which can lead to a little confusion for the visitor).

If you can keep a drive straight and have a decent short game , you will score well and not lose balls. Some interesting double mackenzie style greens which run true.
